



PROPOSE BILLBOARD TO BE LOCATED AT NORTH AND SOUTH ENTRANCES OF THE CITY

Rabbit signs to greet motorists

The Rabbit State Championship Committee moved closer this week to placing billboards at the north and south entrances to Atlanta proclaiming Atlanta as a "State Championship City."

At a meeting this week, committee member Steven Smith unveiled the design of

the billboard for the committee's approval.

The signs will highlight Atlanta High School's Lone Star Cup Award of 2002, its state championship in baseball in 1998, its 2003 state championship in football, its UIL Academics championship in 1999 and its four state championships in track in 1989, 1997, 2002 and 2003.

The committee met with Herbert Stark of Stark Outdoor Advertising as he outlined his proposal for the two 8-foot by 24-foot structures.

The committee still has not finalized the exact location of the signs.
